

# Part A evaluation check list

*Evaluate Part A document (about 500 words) and Appendix (no word count, but has a contents page)*

investigate a situation

*Found in either the appendix or the main document – the client’s problem must be fully discussed*

identify client/adviser

*Make it bold, highlighted – must stand out*

explicitly consult the client (and/or adviser)

*Should have at least 3 transactions/separate pieces of consultation (possibly more!) – normally found in appendix*

*First one explaining the problem, second giving alternative research feedback and agreeing that the problem needs to be solved in Java, third agreeing the success criteria*

describe the scenario with explicit reference to key points from the client consultation

*Must explain how proposed solution will solve the client’s problem*

choose a solution

*Give a single sentence solution, typed in a difference colour surrounded by a box that explains the solution to anyone reading it. It should be simple, sharp, to the point and propose a product name*

describe the rationale for the solution and also for the software to be used

*Must show evidence of alternatives and why they are not meeting the client’s success criteria, must explain why it would be in the client’s interest that you develop the program/solution in Java/etc.*

outline comprehensive Criteria for Success for the chosen solution

*The most fundamental ones must be at the top – the top 2 MUST agree with the proposed solution – if you can give them to another coder and get the same program, they are not specific enough*
